



## **Cockroaches Treatment Preparation Checklist:**

Depending on the initial inspection and/or the information provided by the customer; the treatment will be determined to: Residual Spraying - Fumigation Treatment, OR Baiting Treatment.

### **First: Residual Spraying - fumigation Treatment Preparation Checklist**

Before our technicians arrive for your cockroach spraying treatment, please follow these steps to ensure the effectiveness of the treatment:

- 1. Remove Food and Dishes:** Clear all food items, pet food and dishes from countertops, tables, and sinks. Store them in sealed containers or cabinets.
- 2. Clean and Declutter:** Clean all kitchen surfaces, including countertops, sinks, and stovetops. Declutter areas where cockroaches may hide, such as under sinks and behind appliances. Pay high attention for cleaning the floors behind fridge and stove area.
- 3. Empty the cabinets and drawers:** All Cabinets and drawers in the kitchen should be empty completely. Don't leave anything over the top of the cabinets.
- 4. Cover or Remove Food Preparation Items:** Cover or remove items like toasters, coffee makers, and microwaves. These areas should be free from any food particles.
- 5. In the bathroom:** clear excess items from the medicine cabinet and from the area under the sink.
- 6. Closets preparation:** Clear all closet floors of shoes, etc. It is **NOT NECESSARY** to remove clothes on hangers.
- 7. Furniture:** Move furniture away from walls in the kitchen whenever applicable
- 8. Cover Fish Tanks and Turn Off Air Filtration Systems:** Cover fish tanks with a towel or plastic wrap and turn off air filtration systems to prevent exposure to the treatment chemicals.
- 9. Follow Additional Instructions:** Our technicians may provide additional instructions based on your unique situation. Please follow these instructions carefully for the best results.
- 10. Vacate the Area During Treatment:** For your safety and to allow for thorough treatment, please vacate the treatment area during the treatment and remain outside for the specified time (4 – 6) hours. Anyone who has allergies, asthma, is pregnant, or anyone with respiratory problems please consult your doctor for allowed re-entry time.

### **First: Baiting Treatment Preparation Checklist**

Before our technicians arrive for your cockroach spraying treatment, please follow these steps to ensure the effectiveness of the treatment:

- 1. Removing the utensils:** Remove all dishes and cooking pots from top and bottom of cupboards whatever applicable.
- 2. Clean and Declutter:** Clean all kitchen surfaces, including countertops, sinks, and stovetops. Declutter areas where cockroaches may hide, such as under sinks and behind appliances. Pay high attention for cleaning the floors behind fridge and stove area.
- 3. No Need to Leave your Unit:** AS the products being used have a very low toxicity to humans and pets, and it does not produce vapours or have an odor, it is NOT necessary for people or pets to vacate the unit during or after treatment.
- 4. After the Treatment:** Avoid using any other pest control products (sprays or powders) or cleaning products alongside this treatment, as doing so will reduce its effectiveness.
- 5. Follow Additional Instructions:** Our technicians may provide additional instructions based on your unique situation. Please follow these instructions carefully for the best results.
